#### **RECIPE CORNER**

From "Feast at the Shepherd's Table"

#### POPPY SEED CAKE

**Barb Maines** 

<sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> Cups Poppy Seeds	3/4 Cup Milk	2 1/4 Cup Flour	1 ½ Cup Sugar
4 tsps. Baking Powder	½ tsp Salt	½ Cup Shortening	2 tsps. Vanilla
3 lg. egg whites			

Soak poppy seeds in <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Cup Milk for 2 hours. Sift flour, baking powder and salt. Gradually blend in sugar into shortening. Stir in vanilla. Add flour mixture, alternating with milk and poppy seed. Beat egg whites until stiff and fold into batter. Bake at 350° for 30 minutes in greased pan.

#### Frosting

6 egg yolks

3/4 cup sugar

3 Tablespoons Cornstarch

2 1/4 Cups Milk

Mix cornstarch and sugar in saucepan. Add milk. Beat egg yolks and stir in. Heat over medium heat, stirring constantly until thick, approximately 10 minutes. Refrigerate.
