### From Pastor Moberly....

We wrapped up the conference on Wed., and have been traveling and working ever since across Cambodia, then into Vietnam. Here is a brief summary of the Conference. More will be in our ALWM – Cambodia Newsletter out in a few weeks! I am putting this together quickly in the Hong Kong airport waiting for my flight to the US. I have a short video thank you from Pastor Sam to those who made this possible that should be edited and ready soon. I will forward the link.

### Highlights:

There were 70 people including the young adults 15-25, as well as 8 of the pastors and leaders from 8 of the 12 churches represented. We planned for 100, and he expected 85 after registrations wrapped up. Some 20-25+ were unable to attend at the last minute because their non-Christian parents – who originally said yes to attending, changed their minds. Pray for these young believers! Most had never met the others in their network of churches before the US team joined with Pastor Sam and his pastors and leaders noted above. Our team of 5 from ALWM, and also missionary friend to Vietnam (who must remain unnamed here for security reasons), Pastor Matt, me and the missionary taught on various aspects of discipleship, and also the team shared testimonies. There were times of worship, praying for one another, fellowship, get acquainted games, and a local outing to the famous Angkor Wat historical site nearby which is free for Cambodian citizens.

Pastor Sam said in our debrief that the Bible Teaching on discipleship was exactly what he was hoping for: Biblical, Christ centered and practical for their everyday lives!
