Our congregation is part of an ecumenical ministry helping people in need in our community. Caritas is open once a week on Wednesdays from 11 a.m. - 2 p.m. and is based at St. Francis Episcopal Church on Silver Lake Road in Eagle River.

We will try to keep you updated on what the pantry REALLY NEEDS in any given month. Right now, you can be very helpful in providing any of the following items. Smaller sizes are actually better so that more people can be helped.

Breakfast cereals (cold or hot)

Soups (canned and other styles)

Canned meals like Dinty Moore stews or Beef Ravioli, etc.

Packaged meals like Hamburger Helper
Canned protein like Spam, chicken, tuna, salmon
Creamy Peanut Butter
Jelly
Juice Boxes for kids
After-school treats for kids (all kinds)
Liquid hand soap
Paper towels
Laundry soap

Other items are ALWAYS welcome, but these are the things especially needed right now.
