## **RECIPE CORNER**

Here's a quick and easy breakfast for a crowd! We call it "breakfast in a bag'. You will need a one-gallon sized zip lock bag for each person. Everyone can make their own eggs with whatever they want in it – have each person write their name on their bag with a sharpie. Each bag gets two eggs – only use two! Set out containers of whatever you can think of to put in the eggs – cheese, cooked bacon, tomato, peppers, mushrooms, onion....lots of possibilities! Everyone can put their two eggs in and then add the extras. Mush them around in the bag to mix everything together and make sure the bag is zipped tight. It will work better if most of the air is 'burped' out of the bags. In a large pot, put enough water to fit all of the bags you are making – you may need more than one pot if you have a large group. Make sure the water is boiling and gently drop each bag into the boiling water. Time them for exactly 13 minutes and they will be done. They will easily just roll out of the bags onto a plate.
